

FACTORIES AMENDMENT ACT, 1936.—ORDER EXTENDING  
WORKING-HOURS IN RESPECT OF **NEW ZEALAND WALL-  
BOARDS, LTD., AUCKLAND.**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter  
of the Factories Amendment Act, 1936.

Tuesday, the 31st day of October, 1944

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by  
section 3 (5) of the Factories Amendment Act, 1936, this Court  
doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the limits of hours fixed by paragraph (c) of  
subsection (1) of section 3 of the said Act are hereby  
extended in respect of the factory of New Zealand Wallboards,  
Ltd., Auckland, in the manner and to the extent set forth in  
the New Zealand Wallboards, Ltd., Auckland, Employees'  
award, dated the 31st day of October, 1944 (recorded in 44  
Book of Awards 887).

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the  
date hereof, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of  
October, 1946.
