NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ELECTRICAL WORKERS.—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Electrical Workers' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of September, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 2904.

Wednesday, the 26th day of April, 1944

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Auckland Electrical Workers' Industrial Union of Workers has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Northern Industrial District Electrical

Workers' apprenticeship order, dated the 26th day of September, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 2904: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the Apprenticeship Committee for the trade in the district and has heard the representatives of the employers and workers bound by the said order: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by deleting the word "overtime" in clause 15 thereof, and substituting therefor the words "in excess of forty hours weekly".

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
