NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT SHIPBUILDING AND BOAT-BUILDING.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Shipbuilding and Boatbuilding apprenticeship order, dated the 28th day of July, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 364.

Monday, the 10th day of July, 1944

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Apprenticeship Committee for the industry in the district has made application to the Court for an amendment of the Northern Industrial District Shipbuilding and Boatbuilding apprenticeship order, dated the 28th day of July, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 364: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Apprenticeship Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said order shall be amended by adding to clause 18 thereof the following words: "Any overtime worked by an apprentice shall similarly be credited to the apprentice as part of any year of his apprenticeship."

2. That this order shall take effect on the day of the date hereof.
