
**NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT WESTLAND) FREEZING COMPANIES'
CLERICAL EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the New Zealand (except Westland) Freezing Companies' Clerical Employees' award, dated the 14th day of July, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 622.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the New Zealand (except

Westland) Freezing Companies' Clerical Employees' award, dated the 14th day of July, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 622, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 2 (Salaries), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of salaries which shall be paid by the employers to the officers of the clerical staff employed by them respectively:—

“(iii) Provided that on attaining the age of twenty-one years each worker shall be entitled to receive the basic wage of £3 16s. per week for males and £1 16s. per week for females and shall receive payment of the basic wage until such time as the salaries shown in the above scales show an increase over the basic rate, when the scales shall be reverted to.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1945.
