

NEW ZEALAND WATERFRONT CONTROL COMMISSION  
CLERICAL EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the New Zealand Waterfront Control Commission Clerical Employees' award, dated the 21st day of September, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 666.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the New Zealand Waterfront Control Commission Clerical Employees' award, dated the 21st day of September, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 666, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting clause 1, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

*“Salaries*

“1. The following shall be the minimum rates of salaries which shall be paid by the employers to the officers of the clerical staff employed by them respectively, the same to commence on officers attaining their sixteenth birthday (women being on date of employment), subject to the provisions of the Shops and Offices Act. All office experience after the sixteenth birthday shall count as length of service for the following scale:—

" Thereafter on merit: Provided—

"(i) That any employees receiving a salary in excess of that provided by the above scale shall not have their salary reduced:

"(ii) That on attaining the age of twenty-one years each employee shall be entitled to receive the basic wage and shall receive payment of the basic wage until such time as the salaries shown in the above scale show an increase over the basic wage, when the scale will be reverted to."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
