

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND CARDBOARD-BOX WORKERS
(FEMALE).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Otago and Southland Cardboard-box Workers' (Female) award, dated the 12th day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 321.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Otago and Southland Cardboard-box Workers' (Female) award, dated the 12th day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 321, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be:—

“ Provided that a worker of the age of twenty-one years or upwards shall be paid not less than the basic wage for the time being prevailing.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
