

**DOMINION INDUSTRIES, LTD. (LINSEED PRODUCTS DIVISION),
DUNEDIN EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL
AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Dominion Industries, Ltd. (Linseed Products Division), Dunedin, Employees' industrial agreement, dated the 8th day of March, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 582.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Dominion Industries, Ltd. (Linseed Products Division), Dunedin, Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 8th day of March, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 582, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended—

(i) By deleting subclause (c) of clause 3 (Overtime), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(c) Meal-money at the rate of 2s. per meal shall be allowed workers required to work more than one hour's overtime after the usual time for ceasing work.

“The provisions of clause 5 hereof increasing rates of remuneration shall not apply to the meal-money payment provided in this subclause.”

(ii) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be—

“ Factory workers	2	11½
“ Seed, meal, and oil-store workers	2	9½

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
