AUCKLAND CITY COUNCIL CLERICAL AND OTHER OFFICERS. --AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Auckland City Council Clerical and other Officers' industrial agreement, dated the 7th day of September, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1163.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Auckland City Council Clerical and other Officers' industrial agreement, dated the 7th day of September, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1163, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclause (g) of clause 3 (Remuneration or Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(g) The following shall be the minimum salaries payable to all employees specified in the following grades:—

"(a) The above salaries shall be payable to all male employees entering the Council's service holding the University Entrance Examination or the School Leaving Certificate and not classified under any other grade. In the event of a male employee entering the Council's service without holding the University Entrance Examination or the School Leaving Certificate and not classified in any other grade, the commencing salary shall be at the rate of £95 per annum and thereafter increases shall be in accordance with Grade 1. The salary for the second year being £100 per annum, then in accordance with subsequent increases above mentioned.

"(b) For the purpose of this agreement employees entering the service and holding the following qualifications shall receive the salary payable for the following number of years' service as set out hereunder:—

"Council may allow credit for any other qualification held by any employee, and such credit shall be as may be agreed upon between the Council and the union.

"(c) Any person employed by Council gaining any of the above qualifications during any year shall receive any increase to which he is entitled through gaining such qualification as from the 1st April next following the date on which such qualification is obtained.

Licensed Surveyors after five years' service shall receive an extra £20 per annum.

- "(a) The salaries in this grade shall be payable to all female employees entering the Council's service unless their duties are specified in any other grade.
- "(b) No female employee entering the Council's service after the commencement of this agreement as a typist or shorthand-typist shall proceed beyond the salary of £170 per annum unless she has obtained the Senior Government Examination in shorthand and typing.
- "(c) Female typists or shorthand-typists on passing the Government Intermediate Examination shall be paid an additional £15 per annum.

"(d) No female entering the Council's service after the commencement of this agreement as a junior library assistant shall proceed beyond the salary of £170 per annum unless she has passed Parts 1 and 2 of the General Certificate of the New Zealand Library Association or other approved examination.

"(e) The above salaries shall be payable to library assistants provided that they hold the University Entrance

Examination or School Leaving Certificate.

"(f) Female employees engaged on accounting and bookkeeping machines, posting and analysis machines, and the addressograph operator shall be paid an additional £15 per annum, provided they pass a departmental test of efficiency to be approved between the Council and the union.

"(g) Junior library assistants working broken time shall

be paid a meal allowance of 2s.

" Grade 11 (£236-£251-£271-£291-£306-£326)-

"Cataloguers, Library Department; Librarian, Municipal Reference Library; Branch Librarians, Epsom, Parnell, Grey Lynn, Point Chevalier, Grafton, Remuera, Tamaki, and Avondale.

"None of the above employees shall proceed beyond the salary of £291 per annum unless she holds the Diploma of the New Zealand Library Association or other approved examination.

"Female clerks not otherwise specified in this agree-

ment and after seven years' service.

"Senior Machinist and Instructor, City Treasurer's Department."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
