(ii) By deleting subclause (c) of clause 10 (General Conditions), and substituting therefor the following sub-clause:—

“ (c) Workers required to work overtime after 5.30 p.m. shall be paid 2s. meal-money unless notice of intention to work overtime has been given on the previous working-day.

“ The provisions of clause 6 of this award increasing rates of remuneration shall not apply to the meal-money provided for in this subclause.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
