OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND LAUNDRY WORKERS, DYERS, AND DRY-CLEANERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Otago and Southland Laundry Workers, Dyers, and Dry-cleaners award, dated the 25th day of October, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 834, this Court doth hereby order as follows:---

1. That the said award shall be amended—

(i) By deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 5 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:

"The provisions of clause 6 of this award increasing rates of remuneration shall not apply to the meal-money provided for in this subclause."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
