

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT HAWKE'S BAY) **HOSPITAL BOARDS' GARDENERS AND LABOURERS.**—  
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District (except Hawke's Bay) Hospital Boards' Gardeners and Labourers' award, dated the 12th day of December, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1082.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Industrial District (except Hawke's Bay) Hospital Boards' Gardeners and Labourers' award, dated the 12th day of December, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1082, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting clause 3, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ *Wages*

“ (ii) The gardener-caretaker at McCarthy Home at Lower Hutt shall be paid £5 10s. 8d. per week and shall be supplied with house, light, gas, and heating free of cost. The hours-of-work provisions of this award shall not apply to this worker so long as he is provided with the house rent free, and light, gas, and fuel free of cost.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
