NORTH CANTERBURY LOCAL-BODY LINESMEN, INSPECTORS, AND SERVICEMEN.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the North Canterbury Local-body Linesmen, Inspectors, and Servicemen's award, dated the 16th day of February, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 40.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the North Canterbury Localbody Linesmen, Inspectors, and Servicemen's award, dated the 16th day of February, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 40, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a), (b), and (c) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

"(a) Servicemen shall be paid not less than £6 6s. 8d. per week.

"(b) Linesmen shall be paid at the rate of not less than

3s. 01d. per hour.

- "(c) Inspectors shall be paid not less than £348 16s. 8d. per annum, and such Inspectors shall not be subject to the provisions of clauses 5 and 6 hereof."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
