

SOUTH CANTERBURY ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD EMPLOYEES.—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Canterbury Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the South Canterbury Electric-power Board Employees' award, dated the 28th day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 387.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the South Canterbury Electric-power Board Employees' award, dated the 28th day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 387, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended—

(i) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum weekly rates of wages for the permanent staff shall be as follows:—
