

AUCKLAND AND WELLINGTON FIRE BRIGADES' OFFICERS.—  
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Auckland and Wellington Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 17th day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1121.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Auckland and Wellington Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 17th day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1121, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended—

(i) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 1 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of wages to be paid to the several grades of officers shall be as follows:—

(ii) By deleting paragraph (i) of subclause (c) of clause 15 (Special Provisions relative to the Mechanic employed by the Wellington Fire Board), and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“(i) The minimum wage payable to the mechanic employed by the Wellington Fire Board shall be £6 19s. 8d. per week.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
