
NORTHERN AND WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS
CARDBOARD-BOX, CARTON, AND PAPER-BAG MAKERS.—
APPLICATION TO STRIKE OUT PARTY FROM AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Northern and Wellington

Industrial Districts Cardboard-box, Carton, and Paper-bag Makers' award, dated the 31st day of October, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 943.

JUDGMENT OF THE COURT, DELIVERED BY TYNDALL, J.

THIS is an application to strike out Bryant and May, Bell and Co., Ltd., Wellington, as a party to the Northern and Wellington Industrial Districts Cardboard-box, Carton, and Paper-bag Makers' dispute.

The award was actually made on 31st October, 1944 (44 Book of Awards 943), but in the memorandum to the award it was stated that the above application would be dealt with by the Court in the centre from which it originated.

The grounds for the application are that the company does not employ workers coming within the scope of the award. After hearing evidence, we are satisfied that this contention cannot be upheld, and the application is accordingly dismissed.
