

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **MOTOR ENGINEERS.**—
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Motor Engineers' apprenticeship order, dated the 20th day of February, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 87.

Friday, the 21st day of September, 1945

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Auckland (Twenty-mile Radius) Motor Engineers' Apprenticeship Committee has made application to the Court for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Motor Engineers' apprenticeship order, dated the 20th day of February, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 87: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 23 of the said order shall be amended by inserting the words "or any recognized branch thereof" after the words "motor mechanic" where they first appear in the clause.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
