

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) **CARPENTERS AND JOINERS.**—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District (except Gisborne Judicial District) Carpenters and Joiners' apprenticeship order, dated the 1st day of September, 1936, and recorded in 36 Book of Awards 602.

Friday, the 21st day of September, 1945

WHEREAS by section 5 (2) of the Apprentices Act, 1923, the Court is empowered to amend any order made under section 5 (1) of the said Act: And whereas the Auckland (Twenty-mile Radius) Carpenters and Joiners' Apprenticeship Committee has made application to the Court for amendment of the Northern Industrial District (except Gisborne Judicial District) Carpenters and Joiners' apprenticeship order, dated the 1st day of September, 1936, and recorded in 36 Book of Awards 602: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said committee; Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 6 of the said order shall be deleted, and the following provision substituted therefor:—

“6. The proportion of the total number of apprentices to the total number of journeymen employed by any employer shall be one to not less than three.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
