

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **COOPERS**.—AMENDMENT  
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Coopers' award, dated the 24th day of April, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 318.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern Industrial District Coopers' award, dated the 24th day of April, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 318, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 14th day of May, 1945) shall be amended—

(i) By deleting the figures and symbols "12s. 6d." in subclause (d) of clause 1 (Hours of Work), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols "12s. 8d."

(ii) By deleting the symbols and figures "£6 5s." in clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the symbols and figures "£6 6s. 8d."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
