WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT FISH-SHOP EMPLOYEES.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Fish-shop Employees' award, dated the 28th day of September, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 2442.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Industrial District Fish-shop Employees' award, dated the 28th day of September, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 2442, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 22nd day of May, 1945) shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following clause:—

"(a) Workers shall be paid not less than the wages specified in the following scale:-"First shopman or man in charge ... 5 17 10

"All other workers 5 7 10"

2. That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

3. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
