

**NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT LAUNDRY WORKERS,
DYERS, AND DRY-CLEANERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Laundry Workers, Dyers, and Dry-cleaners' award, dated the 20th day of December, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1153.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern Industrial District Laundry Workers, Dyers, and Dry-cleaners' award, dated the 20th day of December, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1153, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 11th day of May, 1945) shall be amended by deleting the words and figures "Thereafter, £5 5s. per week" in subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages), and substituting therefor the words and figures "Thereafter, £5 6s. 8d. per week."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
