

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **RUBBER-WORKERS.**—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Northern Industrial District Rubber-workers' award, dated the 14th day of December, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1115.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern Industrial District Rubber-workers' award, dated the 14th day of December, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 1115, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 24th August, 1945) shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of pay for adult male workers:—
