

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL BOARDS'
CLERICAL WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL
 AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand; Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Hospital Boards' Clerical Workers' industrial agreement, dated the 2nd day of September, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1317.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Industrial District Hospital Boards' Clerical Workers' industrial agreement, dated the 2nd day of September, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1317, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting the schedule of salaries, and substituting therefor the following schedule of salaries:—
