In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Industrial District Hospital Boards' Clerical Workers' industrial agreement, dated the 2nd day of September, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1317, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting the schedule of salaries, and substituting therefor the following schedule of salaries:—

That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.
