

**DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL SHIFT ENGINEERS (WAIPORI FALLS POWER-STATION, CONVERTER STATION, AND HALF-WAY BUSH SUBSTATION).—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Dunedin City Council Shift Engineers (Waipori Falls Power-station, Converter Station, and Half-way Bush Substation) industrial agreement, dated the 18th day of December, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1867.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Dunedin City Council Shift Engineers (Waipori Falls Power-station, Converter Station, and Half-way Bush Substation) industrial agreement, dated the 18th day of December, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 1867, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 9 of the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting all the words, figures, and symbols preceding the words "The provisions of the Factories Amendment Act, 1936 . . .," and substituting therefor the following:—

"9. The minimum rates for Waipori No. 2 and Converter Station shall be:—

"The rate for Waipori No. 1 Station and Steam-plant shall be the engineers' usual rate of pay, but in no case less than £7 16s. 8d. per week.

2. That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations, 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

3. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
