

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, AND MARLBOROUGH LOCAL
AUTHORITIES' OFFICERS' (ELECTRIC-POWER BOARDS).—
 AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Northern, Wellington, and Marlborough Local Authorities' Officers' (Electric-power Boards) award, dated the 9th day of March, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 248.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern, Wellington, and Marlborough Local Authorities' Officers' (Electric-power Boards) award, dated the 9th day of March, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 248, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting the schedule of salaries in clause 5 (Rates of Pay), and substituting therefor the following schedule of salaries:—

“ Meter-reader (twenty-one years and over), £255 6s. 8d., rising as per scale to a maximum of £322 6s. 8d. at the end of the third year.

“ Cashier (male) if on duty not less than 80 per cent. of full time £13 above Scale ‘A,’ rising as per scale to £355 6s. 8d. at the end of eleventh year.

“ Cashier (female) if on duty not less than 80 per cent. of full time, £13 above Scale ‘B,’ rising as per scale to £208 in eighth year.”

2. That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

3. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
