
**NELSON, WESTLAND, AND CANTERBURY ELECTRIC-SUPPLY
AUTHORITIES' ELECTRICIANS AND LINESMEN.—AMEND-
MENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Nelson, Westland, and Canterbury Electric-supply Authorities' Electricians and Linesmen's award, dated the 19th day of October, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 801.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Nelson, Westland, and Canterbury Electric-supply Authorities' Electricians and

Linesmen's award, dated the 19th day of October, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 801, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clauses (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), and (g) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Servicemen shall be paid not less than £6 6s. 8d. per week.”

“(b) Electrical workers shall be paid at the rate of not less than 3s. 0½d. per hour.”

“(c) Linesmen shall be paid at the rate of not less than 3s. 0½d. per hour.”

“(d) Linesmen's assistants shall be paid at the rate of not less than 2s. 10d. per hour.”

“(e) Labourers shall be paid at the rate of not less than 2s. 8½d. per hour.”

“(g) Inspectors shall be paid not less than £342 6s. 8d. per annum, and such Inspectors shall not be subject to the provisions of clauses 5 and 6 hereof.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
