

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, AND MARLBOROUGH INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS LOCAL AUTHORITIES' OFFICERS (COUNTY COUNCILS, ROAD BOARDS, RIVER BOARDS, AND DRAINAGE BOARDS).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Northern, Wellington, and Marlborough Industrial Districts Local Authorities' Officers (County Councils, Road Boards, River Boards, and Drainage Boards) award, dated the 19th day of December, 1938, and recorded in 38. Book of Awards 3767.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern, Wellington,

and Marlborough Industrial Districts Local Authorities' Officers' (County Councils, Road Boards, River Boards, and Drainage Boards) award, dated the 19th day of December, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 3767, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a), (b), and (d) of clause 3 (Rates and Conditions of Pay), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Subject to the provisions of the Shops and Offices Act, except in the case of workers specifically classified, all male workers shall be paid in accordance with the following scale when they reach the age of seventeen years until they reach the maximum of £342 6s. 8d. per annum:—

“(b) Subject to the provisions of the Shops and Offices Act, female shorthand-typists and other female members of the administrative staff who are not specifically classified shall be paid in accordance with the following scale when they reach the age of sixteen years until they reach the maximum of £195 per annum:—

“(d) The following workers are specifically classified, and shall receive the salary mentioned as a minimum:—

“Engineering and professional cadets, £93 per annum as a commencing rate, and thereafter increments as provided in subclause (a) hereof.

“Engineers’ Assistant and Draughtsman, £290 6s. 8d. per annum.

“Qualified Assistant Engineer, £355 6s. 8d. per annum.

“Assistant County Clerk (in charge of four or more), £330 6s. 8d. per annum.

“Accountant, £330 6s. 8d. per annum.

“Senior Female Book-keeper (full time), £236 per annum.

“Noxious-weeds Inspector, £255 6s. 8d. per annum.

“Cashier, male (if on duty as cashier full time), £255 6s. 8d. per annum.

“Cashier, female (if on duty as cashier full time), £176 per annum.

“All workers in the foregoing classification shall be paid not less than the amount to which they would be entitled under this clause if not specifically classified.”

2. That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

3. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
