WESTLAND ENGINEERING, METAL-WORKING, AND MOTOR TRADES.—AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Westland Engineering, Metal-working, and Motor Trades' apprenticeship order, dated the 7th day of July, 1925, and recorded in 25A Book of Awards 599.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf for amendment of the Westland Engineering, Metal-working, and Motor Trades' apprenticeship order, dated the 7th day of July, 1925, and recorded in 25A Book of Awards 599, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by deleting clause 8, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

2. That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively,

it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided for by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

- 3. That this order shall, on and from the date on which it takes effect, be deemed to apply according to its tenor to all contracts of apprenticeship in force on that date and entered into subject to the provisions of the said apprenticeship order.
- 4. That this order shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 1st day of July, 1945.
