

DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL AND DUNEDIN DRAINAGE AND SEWERAGE BOARD **INSPECTORS**.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Dunedin City Council and Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board Inspectors' industrial agreement, dated the 21st day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1145.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Dunedin City Council and Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board Inspectors' industrial agreement, dated the 21st day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1145, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended—

(i) By deleting clause 6, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“Meal Allowance

“6. An employee who is required to work after 6 p.m. on any day and cannot reasonably get home for a meal shall be paid a meal allowance of 2s.: Provided that this allowance shall not be paid to shift-workers.

“The provisions of subclause (g) of clause 12 of this agreement increasing rates of remuneration shall not apply to the meal-money payment provided for in this clause.”

(ii) By deleting subclause (f) of clause 12 (Remuneration or Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(f) The following shall be the minimum wages payable to all employees specified in the following schedule:—

“*Provided that any inspector engaged permanently on infectious diseases work shall receive £10 per annum additional to the above-mentioned rates.

“*A ‘Sanitary Inspector’ shall mean and include any person who is qualified to carry out the duties of a Health or Sanitary Inspector in terms of section 25 of the Health Act, 1920.
