DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL AND DUNEDIN DRAINAGE AND INSPECTORS.—AMENDMENT SEWERAGE BOARD OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Dunedin City Council and Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board Inspectors' industrial agreement, dated the 21st day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards. 1145

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Dunedin City Council and Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board Inspectors' industrial agreement, dated the 21st day of September, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1145, this Court doth herebyorder as follows:----

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended—

(i) By deleting clause 6, and substituting therefor thefollowing clause :-

" Meal Allowance

"6. An employee who is required to work after 6 p.m. on any day and cannot reasonably get home for a meal shall bepaid a meal allowance of 2s.: Provided that this allowance shall not be paid to shift-workers.

"The provisions of subclause (g) of clause 12 of this: agreement increasing rates of remuneration shall not apply to the meal-money payment provided for in this clause."

(ii) By deleting subclause (f) of clause 12 (Remuneration) or Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:----

"(f) The following shall be the minimum wages payableto all employees specified in the following schedule :---
