
WELLINGTON CITIES AND BOROUGHES **LOCAL AUTHORITIES'**
OFFICERS.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Wellington Cities and

Boroughs Local Authorities' Officers' industrial agreement, dated the 7th day of November, 1940, and recorded in 40 Book of Awards 2173.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Cities and Boroughs Local Authorities' Officers' industrial agreement, dated the 7th day of November, 1940, and recorded in 40 Book of Awards 2173, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Grade "A" schedule of salaries provided for in subclause (a) of clause 1 of the said industrial agreement shall be deleted and the following provision substituted therefor:—

"Grade 'A.'—Male clerical and other workers unclassified in the said award and this agreement (not to apply to workers who commence employment under the age of seventeen years until they reach such age):—

That, for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

3. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
