

DUNEDIN **FIRE - BRIGADES' EMPLOYEES.**—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Dunedin Fire Brigades' Employees' award, dated the 12th day of May, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 150.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Dunedin Fire Brigades'

Employees' award, dated the 12th day of May, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 150, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(i) By deleting subclauses (a), (d), and (g) of clause 6 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

“(d) Married men who are not provided with quarters shall be granted a house allowance of £1 4s. per week.”

“(g) Part-time workers shall be paid as follows:—

“Retaining Fee: Nil.

“For Fire Duty: For first hour or part thereof, 3s. 3½d.; for each succeeding hour or part thereof, 2s. 9½d.

“False-alarm Calls: 2s. 6d. per call between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. (no payment between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 p.m.)

“For Night Duty: 2s. 9½d. per night, subject to a signing-on at 7 p.m. (minimum attendance, three nights in each week; no maximum).”

(ii) By deleting the figures and symbols “2s. 6d.” in clause 9 (Special Duties), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols “5s.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
