

AUCKLAND, WELLINGTON, CHRISTCHURCH, AND DUNEDIN  
**JOURNALISTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin Journalists' award, dated the 18th day of March, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 225.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch, and Dunedin Journalists' award, dated the 18th day of March, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 225, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clauses (a) and (d) of clause 11 (Salaries), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

" Provided that any worker of the age of twenty-one years and upwards shall be paid not less than the basic wage for the time being prevailing."

" (d) Women journalists of not less than five years' experience and in charge of a department shall receive a salary of not less than £6 0s. 6d. a week."

2. That for the purpose of removing doubts as to the operation of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively, it is hereby declared that the amended rates of remuneration provided by this order shall be increased to the extent and in the manner set forth in the said two general orders of the Court.

3. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
