NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, AND NELSON TOBACCO-WORKERS.--AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Northern, Wellington, and Nelson Tobacco-workers' award, dated the 23rd day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 332.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern, Wellington, and Nelson Tobacco-workers' award, dated the 23rd day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 332, this Court doth hereby order as follows :---

1. That the said award shall be amended-

(i) By deleting clause 4, and substituting therefor the following clause :---

(ii) By deleting clause 5, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

" Casual Workers

"5. Male adult workers employed for less than one week shall be deemed to be casual workers and shall be paid at the rate of 3s. 0¹/₂d. per hour. When casual labour is employed, a minimum of four hours shall be paid."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
