

WESTLAND **TIMBER-WORKERS.**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Westland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Westland Timber-workers' award, dated the 20th day of August, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1057.

Wednesday, the 15th day of August, 1946

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Westland Timber-workers' award, dated the 20th day of August, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1057, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of all the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(i) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 16 (Payment of Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“Wages shall be payable in cash at regular fortnightly intervals. Payment in full shall be made not later than the Wednesday in each alternate week of all wages payable in respect of the fortnightly period terminating on and including the preceding Saturday. The first such payment shall be made not later than the 21st day of August, 1946, and shall be in respect of the fortnightly period ending on the 17th day of August, 1946.”

(ii) By deleting clause 18 (Foreman).

2. That this order shall take effect on the day of the date hereof.
