

**INVERCARGILL FIRE BRIGADE EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Invercargill Fire Brigade Employees' award, dated the 28th day of May, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 423.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Invercargill Fire Brigade Employees' award, dated the 28th day of May, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 423, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

(1) That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

(2) That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 1945.
