

**WELLINGTON FOREMEN STEVEDORES, TIMEKEEPERS, AND
PERMANENT HANDS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Wellington Foremen Stevedores, Timekeepers, and Permanent Hands' award, dated the 16th day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 341.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Foremen

Stevedores, Timekeepers, and Permanent Hands' award, dated the 16th day of June, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 341, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 20th day of April, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(i) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Foremen and Timekeepers' Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

| “(a) Head foremen stevedores (in companies where six or more foremen stevedores are employed) .. | Per Week. |

(ii) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Permanent Hands in Charge of Oil-hulks), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Wages.—The weekly wages shall be at the rate of £6 0s. 4d. with free quarters, light, and heating.”

(iii) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Permanent Hands in Charge of Coal-hulks), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Wages.—The weekly wage shall be at the rate of £5 2s. 10d., with free quarters, light, and heating.”

(iv) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 6 (Permanent Hands), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Wages.—The weekly wage shall be at the rate of £5 12s. 10d.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
