

TARANAKI BUTCHERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Taranaki Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Taranaki Butchers' award, dated the 29th day of May, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 455.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Taranaki Butchers' award, dated the 29th day of May, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 455, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

(1) That subclause (a) of clause 2 (Wages) of the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 23rd May, 1945) shall be deleted, and the following subclause substituted therefor:—

“(a) Workers shall be paid not less than the wages specified in the following scale:—

“ Second shopman	6	5	4
“ First small-goods man	6	17	10
“ Slaughterman	6	5	4
“ Man in charge of hawking cart ..	6	5	4
“ All other workers	5	17	10”

(2) That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 14th day of March, 1946.
