

AUCKLAND HOSPITAL BOARD'S **ENGINEERS.**—AMENDMENT  
OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Auckland Hospital Board's Engineers' industrial agreement, dated the 2nd day of November, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1561.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Auckland Hospital Board's Engineers' industrial agreement, dated the 2nd day of November, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1561, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting from subclause (a), clause 3 (Wages), the figure and symbol "3s.," and substituting therefor the figures and symbols "3s. 3½d."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
