

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **ABATTOIR EMPLOYEES.**
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Wellington Industrial District Abattoir Employees' award, dated the 19th day of July, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 533.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Wellington Industrial District Abattoir Employees' award, dated the 19th day of July, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 533, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That clause 3 (Wages) of the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 18th May, 1945) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Workers shall be paid not less than the rates specified in the following schedule:—

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 1945.
