

NEW ZEALAND ENGINE-DRIVERS, FIREMEN, AND GREASERS
(GENERAL SECTION).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Factories Amendment Act, 1945; and in the matter of the New Zealand Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Greasers' (General Section) award, dated the 29th day of August, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1473.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 4 of the Factories Amendment Act, 1945, and upon application made by parties to the New Zealand Engine-drivers, Firemen, and Greasers' (General Section) award, dated the 29th day of August, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1473, this Court, with the consent of the parties concerned, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the rates of wages prescribed by the said award, in so far as they relate to engine- and locomotive-drivers employed by freezing companies bound by the said award, shall be adjusted in the manner following:—

(1) By substituting the figures “£6 10s.” for the figures “£5 18s. 2d.” in paragraphs (a), (b), and (d) of subclause (i) of clause 8.

(2) By substituting the figures “£6 4s. 6d.” for the figures “£5 13s. 2d.” in paragraph (e) of subclause (i) of clause 8.

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 2nd day of January, 1946.
