

NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT CANTERBURY AND WESTLAND)
FRUIT AND PRODUCE STORES' EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Canterbury and Westland) Fruit and Produce Stores' Employees' award, dated the 9th day of November, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1572.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of

giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a), (c), and (d) of clause 5 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Workers over the age of twenty-one years shall be paid not less than £6 10s. 6d. per week.”

“(c) Youths may be employed at not less than the following rates:—

“(d) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing, females may be employed packing and sorting fruit and eggs, receiving and preparing flowers for sale, and work incidental to the foregoing operations, at not less than the following:—

“ Provided that a worker of the age of twenty-one years or upwards shall be paid not less than £3 3s. per week.”

(2) By deleting the figures and symbols “3s.” in clause 6 (Casual Workers), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols “3s. 4½d.”

(3) By deleting clause 7 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
