

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND  
SOUTHLAND **DENTAL TECHNICIANS AND DENTAL  
ASSISTANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Dental Technicians and Dental Assistants' award, dated the 18th day of September, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1346.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3, and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages for the respective classes of workers:—

	Per Week.

“(a) Dental technicians ..	7	19	5
“(b) Dental process workers ..	6	18	5”

(2) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 5, and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

	Per Week.

“ Juniors under eighteen years of age	1	16	6
“ Juniors eighteen years of age and over	2	9	0
“ Provided that female workers twenty years of age shall not be paid less than £3 6s. per week.			

“ The above payments shall be increased each six months by 5s. per week until a wage of £4 1s. 3d. is reached.

“ After the completion of three years of service the worker shall then be classed as a senior and shall be paid not less than £4 1s. 3d. per week.”

(3) By deleting clause 13 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
