

WELLINGTON AND CANTERBURY JEWELLERS, WATCH-
MAKERS, ENGRAVERS, AND DIE-SINKERS.—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington and Canterbury Jewellers, Watchmakers, Engravers, and Die-sinkers' award, dated the 12th day of December, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 3695.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 23rd day of July, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting from subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) the amount of “£6 1s. 8d.,” and substituting therefor the amount of “£7 2s. 9d.”

(2) By inserting, after clause 3 (Wages), the following new clause:—

“Exclusion from Operation of General Orders

“3A. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
