NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT) CYCLE-WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Northern Industrial District) Cycleworkers' award, dated the 21st day of September, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 713.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 13th day of September, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—
- (1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause :—
- "(a) Except as otherwise provided in clause 8 (d), the minimum rate of wages for workers twenty-one years of age and over shall be $3s. 5\frac{1}{4}d$. per hour."
 - (2) By deleting clause 6 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).
- (3) By deleting subclause (d) of clause 8 (Assistants), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(d) The following minimum weekly rates of wages shall be payable to assistants:—
