

TARANAKI ELECTRICAL WORKERS (RADIO SECTION).—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Taranaki Electrical Workers' (Radio Section) award, dated the 4th day of April, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 739.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in

that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 10th day of August, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 4 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

“Thereafter not less than the wage hereinbefore provided for adults.”

(2) By inserting, after clause 4 (Wages), the following new clause:—

“ Exclusion from Operation of General Orders

“4A. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
