

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **FILM-EXAMINERS.**—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Film-examiners' award, dated the 16th day of October, 1942, and recorded in 42 Book of Awards 1193.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by Order of the Court dated the 21st day of February, 1946) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting clause 3, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ *Wages*

“ Any worker, who, on the coming into force of this award, is in receipt of higher rates of wages than set out herein shall not have his or her wages reduced whilst in the present employment.”

(2) By deleting clause 4 (General Orders under Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
