DUNEDIN CITY CORPORATION THEATRICAL CLEANERS AND CARETAKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin City Corporation Theatrical Cleaners and Caretakers' award, dated the 13th day of March, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 133.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows :---

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 20th day of September, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following :—

(1) By deleting clause 2, and substituting therefor the following clause :—

" Wages

"2. (a) The minimum wages of cleaners shall be £6 6s. per week.

"(b) Should any worker be required to work in any capacity in connection with any function other than a dance for which the Concert Chamber or Town Hall is engaged, he shall be paid the sum of 11s. for time worked between 7 p.m. and 11 p.m. and 3s. 4d. for extra time worked from 11 p.m. to midnight, and 5s. per hour after midnight. In respect of dances, the rate shall be 16s. 9d. up to midnight, and 5s. per hour after midnight.

"(c) Wages shall be paid weekly in cash in employer's time."

(2) By deleting the amount of "2s. 8d." in subclause (b) of clause 3 (Casual Workers), and substituting therefor the amount of "3s. 2d."

(3) By deleting clause 12, and substituting therefor the following clause :—

"Exclusion from Operation of General Orders

"12. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall not be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively." 2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
