## NORTH CANTERBURY HOSPITAL BOARD LAUNDRY WORKERS.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the North Canterbury Hospital Board Laundry Workers' award dated the 9th day of March, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 136.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. That the said award (as amended by Order of the Court dated the 10th day of September, 1945) shall be further amended in the following manner:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause :—

" (a) The following shall be the minimum weekly rates of wages :----
