

NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND) **AERATED-WATER AND CORDIAL WORKERS.**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Otago and Southland) Aerated-water and Cordial Workers' award, dated the 27th day of April, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 218.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a) and (c) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The minimum rates of pay for male workers over the age of twenty-one years shall be:—

“(c) Casual workers shall be paid not less than 3s. 3¼d. per hour.”

(2) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Female Workers), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Female workers may be employed at not less than the following weekly rates:—

(3) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Youths), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
